By the Associate Bureau Chief, Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau:

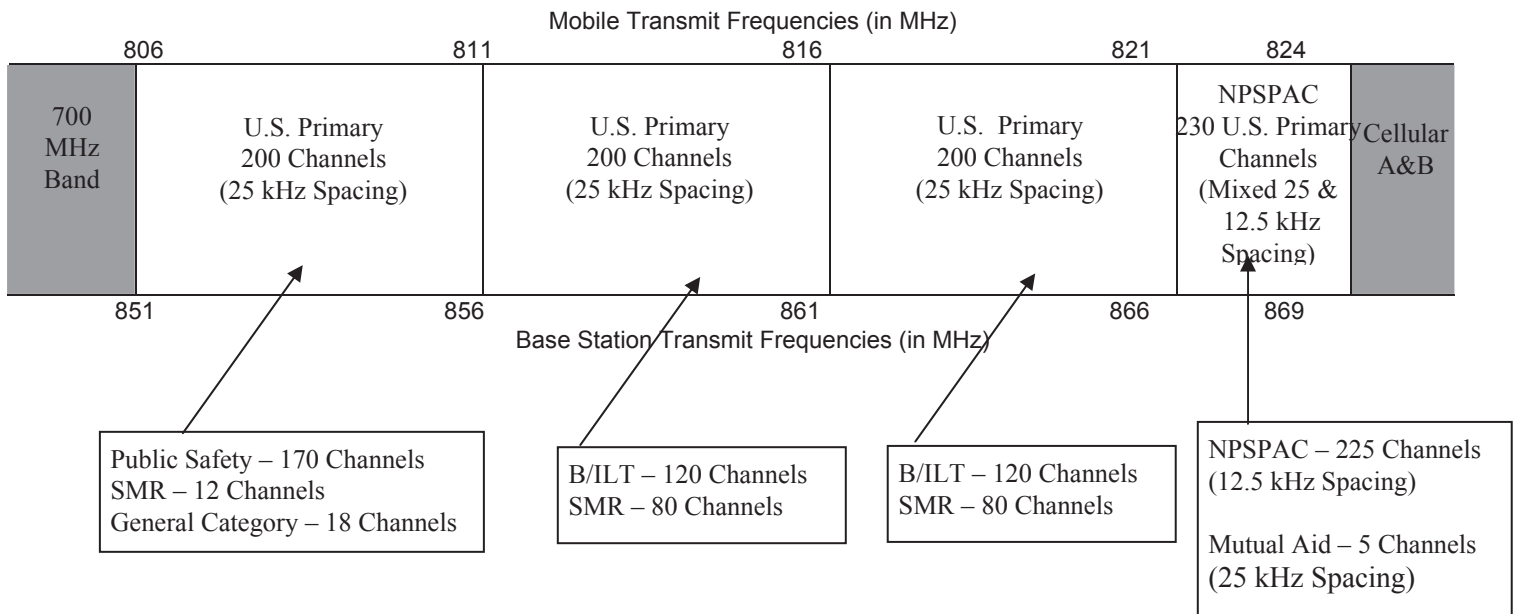
On May 9, 2008, the Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau released a *Second Report and Order*, DA 08-1094, in the above-captioned proceeding. This Erratum corrects the document as follows:

1. In paragraph 51, the Ordering Clause should read as:

“IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the amendments of the Commission’s Rules set forth in Appendix D ARE ADOPTED, effective sixty days from the date of publication in the Federal Register.”

2. In Appendix C-4, the Pre-Rebanding Band Plan for Canadian Border Region 7 should appear as follows:

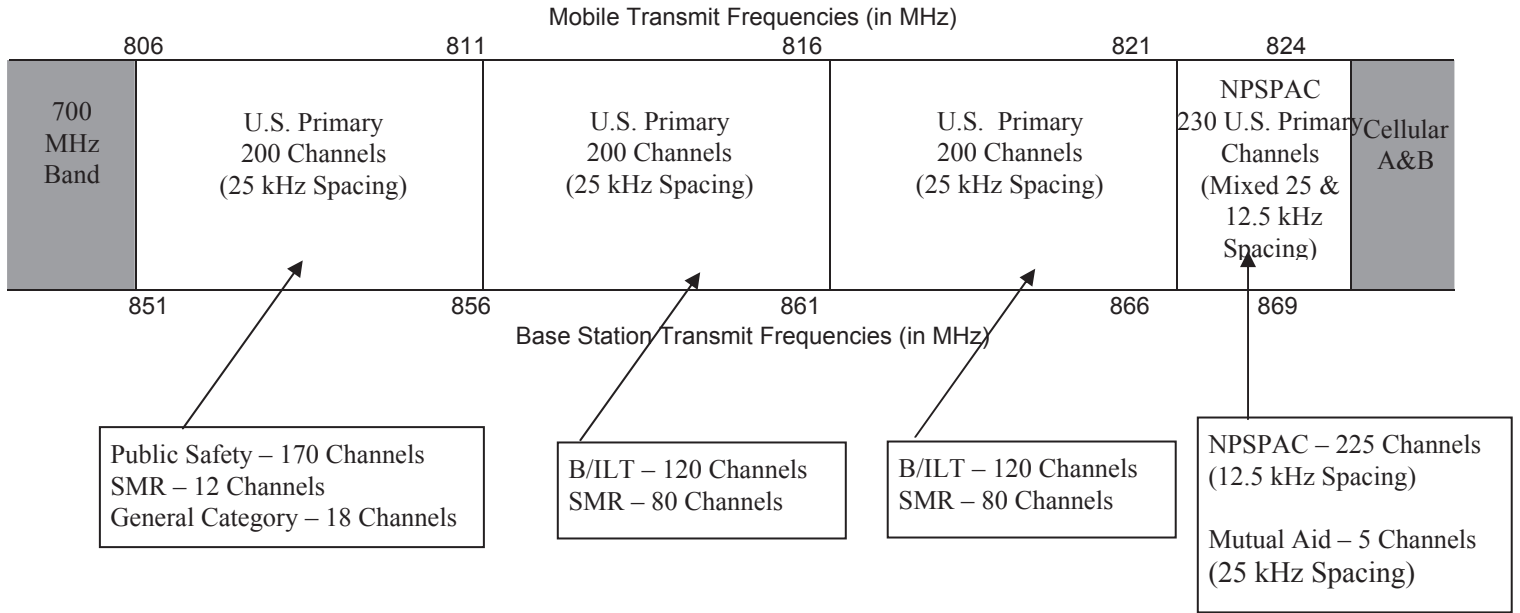
Current Band Plan – Canadian Border Region 7
