**PUBLIC SAFETY AND HOMELAND SECURITY BUREAU ANNOUNCES COMMENT AND
REPLY COMMENT DATES FOR THE NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING SEEKING
COMMENT ON ESTABLISHING AND IMPLEMENTING A RECONFIGURED 800 MHZ
CHANNEL PLAN ALONG THE U.S.-MEXICO BORDER**

On August 17, 2012, the Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau released a Fourth Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking in WT Docket No. 02-55 seeking comment on proposals for establishing and implementing a reconfigured 800 MHz channel plan along the U.S.-Mexico border.¹ The *Fourth FNPRM* set deadlines for filing comments and reply comments at 30 and 45 days after publication in the Federal Register.²

On August 30, 2012, the Office of the Federal Register published a summary of the *Fourth FNPRM* and associated comment and reply comment dates.³ Accordingly, comments must be filed on or before October 1, 2012; and reply comments must be filed on or before October 15, 2012.⁴ The *Fourth FNPRM* sets forth the comment filing instructions.
